Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ sharing for affiliates’ everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness ▪ affiliates from using your information to market to you ▪ sharing for non-affiliates to market to you <p>TrustFirst only shares information in order to process your transactions, maintain your account(s) or respond to auditors, consultants, examiners or court orders and legal investigations.</p> <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>
